CowBelles Announce Beef Plan

Members of the XIT CowBelles group are currently working toward urging all residents to use Beef Gift Certificates for all special occasions.

The Beef Certificates will be available in denominations from \$5 to \$1,000 and good at any bank in the area.

"The Beef Gift Certificate program is designed to promote the sales of beef and work toward a healthier economy in our area," CowBelle spokesmen said.

The Beef Gift certificates may be purchased locally by contacting Mrs. Jack Dettle or seeing either Ann Steward or Martha Mitts at The First State Bank of Stratford.

In addition to Beef Gift Certificates, CowBelles also have packages of 350 napkins imprinted with area brands on them for sale. Napkins are \$3.50 per package and these may be purchased by contacting Mrs. Janet Riffe.

All Texas CowBelles groups are cooperating in a Beef for Girlstown drive this year. The Girlstown facilities at Borger, Whiteface and Austin will benefit by the effort.

It takes a total of 52 beeves a year for the three facilities to provide a minimum of 6 ounces of beef per girl per day. Money donations, or live beef, will be accepted for this program.

Any money is placed in a special Girlstown account and used for this purpose.

At present the program has resulted in 16 beeves, two cows, three heifers and three hogs have been donated plus \$1,700 in cash over the State of Texas.

Area truckers are cooperating and area packing facilities are donating their time and facilities for handling the beef.

Our cook has given us three recipes that we hope you enjoy using.

CREAMED TACOS

Fry 1 1/2 lbs. ground beef with salt, pepper and chili

powder to taste. Set aside. Cook the following until the cheese melts:

- 1 c. tomatoes
- 1 c. evaporated milk
- 1 can chopped green chilies
- 1 chopped onion
- 1 lb. American cheese

Place hamburger in tortillas that have been dipped in hot grease. Roll up, put in baking dish and pour cheese mixture over it. Heat until hot in moderate oven.

FRENCH COCONUT PIE

- 1 unbaked 9 inch pie shell
- 1 stick melted oleo
- 1 1/2 c. sugar
- 3 eggs
- 1 T. vanilla
- 1 T. vinegar
- 1 can flaked coconut

Mix together and pour into unbaked pie shell. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.

ITALIAN SQUASH

5 or 6 medium sized yellow squash. Parboil for a short time. While still firm, put in baking dish-1 layer of squash, 1 layer of chopped onion, 1 medium chopped pepper, 2 cups of grated cheddar cheese. After layering squash, onion, pepper and cheese, top with remainder of cheese. Pour 1 small can of tomato sauce. Bake in moderate oven until cheese begins to brown and gets bubbly on top.
