Good Samaritans Fill County With Genuine Christmas Spirit

While tales of crime, fraud and man's inhumanity to man fill the headlines the rest of the year, Christmastime brings relief from all the negative news and headlines bear tales of the goodness in man.

"I said a little prayer and it was answered, almost before I could hang up the telephone," the Salvation Army Representative in Mitchell County, County Judge Bill Carter said.

"The Christmas season seems to bring out the loving spirit in people more than any other time of year."

"Not only are more

people willing to help less fortunate persons, but people in need are more willing to put aside false pride and admit their needs," he said.

He said the prayer he had reference to was

made just after he received a report that a mother had abandoned five young children, the oldest of which was 13.

The children were temporarily placed in the home of an aunt with one child of her own.

The children's uncle is disabled and income for the family is very limited, Judge Carter said.

The problem of what to do about the situation was solved, at least in part, when a local resident contacted Judge

Carter and expressed a desire to give assistance to some needy family this Christmas.

Groceries, clothing and shoes were immediately purchased for the youngsters and the Christmas outlook is

much brighter than it was before the small prayer was made.

A second problem was presented to the judge only minutes later when a young woman expecting a baby in January. See GOOD Page 5B

Highway Patrolman Buddy Hertenberger was awarded a plaque as "Law Enforcement Officer of the Year" for his meritorious service.

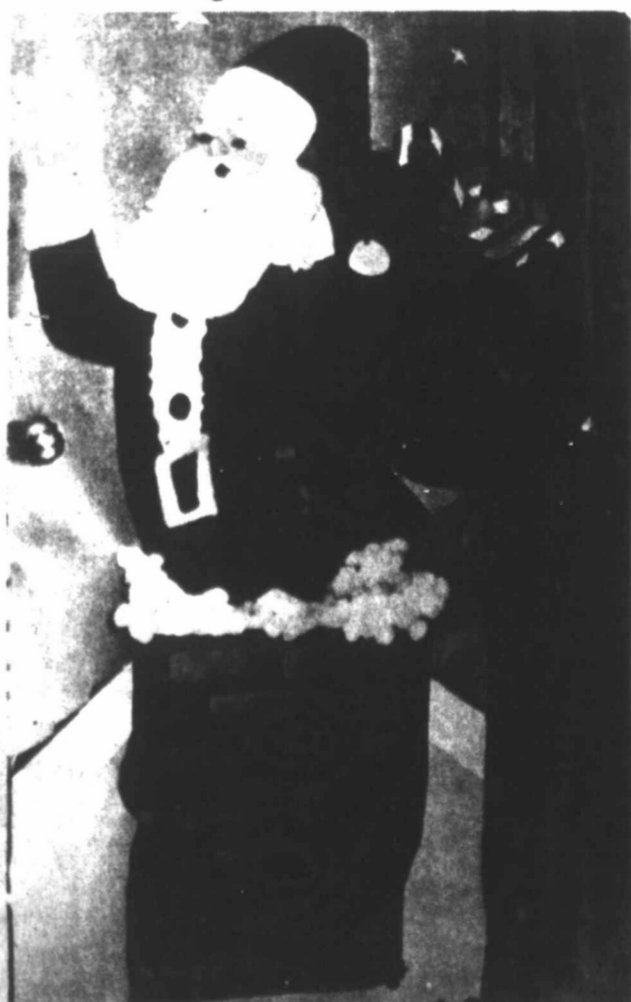
"He was the only one of us who didn't goof up this year," Trooper Costabile said.

The phone rang just as she left the office, Judge Carter said, and it was someone interested in assisting the needy at Christmastime.
The person on the tele-

phone represented the local CB Club and contacted the club members with the prospect of assisting the young woman on a continuing basis, until she is able to support herself and the children.
The club members agreed and this family will not only have a much nicer Christmas but also a happier new year, Judge Carter said.

On December 8, 1980, the Mitchell County Commissioners Court amended the Rules and Regulations governing the water and shorelines of Lake Colorado City which were approved on October 25, 1976, to include the following:

Containers which have contained pesticides, herbicides or any other type of chemical which may be toxic, corrosive, flammable or otherwise dangerous to human health or the environment, shall not be used as floats or for any other purpose in or near Lake Colorado City and Lake Champion. These containers may be disposed of in accordance with regulations of the Texas Department of Health, the Texas Department of Water Resources, the Texas Department of Agriculture and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. 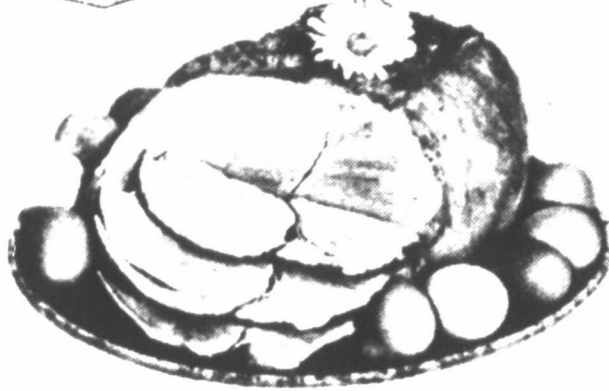

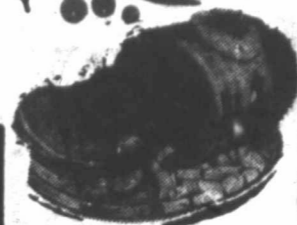

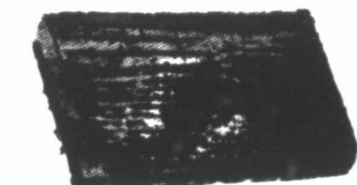
