Icy conditions contribute to major accident

A domino-like accident involving six vehicles injured one seriously Wednesday morning and saw several others treated and released at the Mitchell County Hospital.

A Bedford man who had stopped to render aid to the people involved in the initial collision was pinned between the guard rail and one wrecked tractor-trailer rig and was transferred by helicopter to Lubbock. Grant Dostert suffered severe leg injuries in the accident.

The accident happened at the crest of the overpass in Loraine under extreme icy conditions shortly after 8 a.m.

DPS Trooper Robert Maldonado said two tractor-trailer rigs, two mini-vans and two automobiles were involved in the accident.

The accident occurred when one of the vans lost control at the top of the overpass and one of the 18-wheelers tried to avoid hitting it but it too went out of control and they collided into each other and the guard rail.

The Dostert vehicle came upon the scene of the first accident and the occupants got out to aid the occupants of the first wreck. Another tractor-trailer then slid into both vehicles, pinning Dostert, followed by collisions by one more mini-van and a Ford Tempo and a Hyunda.

World War II was main focus on Christmas fifty years ago

All the service men visiting in the county—soldier, sailor, marine, Coast Guard and any WAVES and WACs were invited to a party to be held at the Mitchell County Service Club Room, said the Colorado City Record on December 24, 1943.

This was not the only story about World War II on the front

page of the Christmas Eve edition.

One story told of Corporal Don Henderson's fight with the Japanese in the South Pacific on the island of Tarawa. This battle has been described as one of the bloodiest and costliest assaults ever made by the United States Marine Corps. His letter home assured his family that he was "okay, as there is a boy from Big Spring sitting here with me fanning off the flies while I write. Everything is okay now."

Pvt. Vernon Hays was okay too but he was home after suffering a bullet wound in the chest in a battle at Munda in New Georgia. When asked if he was glad to be home, he replied, "You'll never know. Not until you've slept in a foxhole plunked down in a jungle crawling with Japs will you ever know how sweet home looks."

Pat Bullock was serving as the Mitchell County War Bond Chairman and she was urging citizens to buy War Bonds for Christmas presents.

The State Highway Commission was ready to pave Highway 208 to Robert Lee, as only 7 miles were currently paved. But they, like a lot of people, were going to have to wait until the war was over to start the project.

Approval of the project was

marked "Post-War" due to the shortage of men and materials. The

To fill Craddock's post Robert Hoback, Jr., selected to fill Hospital Board position

Robert Hoback, Jr., was unanimously selected to fill an unexpired term on the Mitchell County Hospital Board that occurred when Jay Craddock resigned earlier this month for health reasons.

Hoback's name was the only one put in nomination at the Wednesday night meeting.

Marion Bassham will serve as the board's president and Fred Thompson will serve as the vice-president.

It was mostly routine business for the board as they heard reports from Hospital Administrator Wendell Alford, Home Health Care Director Sandra Gaylean and Valley Fair Lodge Director, Marsha Rickard.

Bill Everett also presented the ambulance report for the month of November. The board also approved purchasing a new communications system for the ambulance service that will include a new repeater system, pagers, hand held radios with phone patches and a new base station.

Alford told the board that he had heard some very good comments about the service and their employees following the six-vehicle wreck on I-20 by Loraine earlier Wednesday morning.

Everett said all three ambulances went on the call.

Alford also gave the medical report and told the board that a physician would probably need to be hired for a period of some six months to staff the Rural Health Clinic and to take the burden off Dr. Doe Roach until the new doctor from California, Dr. Gus Gross, arrives.

road was referred to as Ranch Road Number 18 by Mitchell County residents.

Most of the advertisements in the Christmas Edition of 1993 carried greetings from Mitchell County residents but Safeway was still advertising specials for the holiday meals.

"Waste-free, dressed and drawn" turkeys were 53¢ a pound—you can buy them cheaper today—but the real savings was on ham.

Half or whole hams were only 34¢ a pound and center slices were 49¢ a pound. Bacon was 37¢ a pound sliced and one could save 4¢ per pound by buying slab bacon.

A 14 oz. bottle of catsup was 15¢ and two bottles of ginger ale were 25¢ for the quart bottles. But you had to pay the deposit.

A dime would buy a 24 oz. loaf of bread or a #2 can of tomatoes or a pound of oranges.

Add nine more cents and you could get a pound box of Sunshine crackers and a pound of coffee was 20¢.

Safeway remembered the war also as they stated in their ad that the best gift of all was War Bonds.

"Riding High" was the movie at the Palace Theatre on December 26 and 27 and it starred Dorothy Lamour and Dick Powell.

The Ritz was showing "Pistol Packin' Mama."

Kids could get into the movies for 11¢ and on Tuesday and Wednesday they got a real bargain—a nickel. Prices for adults ranged from 25¢ to 33¢.


Reily speaks to A.A.R.P.



Perry comments on election cost

One of the freedoms we hold dear as Americans and Texans is the right of all our citizens to participate in the electoral process.

This includes the right to vote, as well as the right to run for office.

However, as with any right, there are responsibilities which cannot be separated from the privilege of being a candidate for elected office.

It has often been stated that freedom is not free and this is true

with the freedom to have elections. This freedom has cost many of our countrymen their lives, given in the defense of this nation. It has cost others their careers, sacrificed in service to others.

There is one more way that elections cost: they cost money.

The best estimate of costs for Texas elections in 1988 puts the bill at \$10.2 million.

This represents the expenses of printing ballots, maintenance of the voting machines, paying election judges and numerous other costs.

Someone must pay this freedom and under our system much of the cost of the elections is paid

by the candidates through the filing fees they pay to run. These fees range from as little as \$50 for some local offices to as much as \$4,000 for presidential candidates.

Finding qualified individuals who are willing to place their names before the public has always been difficult.

In 1975 the Texas Legislature made it possible for prospective candidates to file signature petitions in lieu of paying the filing fee for their office. This was done, in particular, to prevent the fee from blocking anyone's candidacy, regardless of personal wealth.

However, some candidates have been abusing the right of filing by petition.

As has been noted, the financial cost of an election is borne by the various candidates through their filing fees paid.

Whenever local funds are insufficient to cover election costs, the state is obligated to make up the difference. This means that a candidate who qualifies by using a petition has his share of the election cost financed by the taxpayers of the state.

It seems wrong to me for candidates who are financially able (to pay a filing fee) to use petitions simply to avoid paying their fair share.

One local candidate recently stated that he didn't believe in filing fees, that they were simply an example of wasteful government spending and that he hoped to bring financial responsibility to the office he was seeking.

The truth is, filing fees are privately paid and by using a petition that individual was asking the taxpayers to fund his candidacy, thus causing more government spending, not less.
