LABELING OF BACK OF RATION CARD IS ADVISED

Passenger automobile owners who have been asking: "Why write the license number and state on the back of each mileage ration coupon," were given the answer Tuesday by Howard Gholson, Lubbock district manager of the Office of Price Administration.

"The reason for writing these identifications on the back of each of the mileage coupons," he said, "will make the book valuable to anyone except the owner. Recovery of stolen books or lost books thus is made easier. Counterfeit coupons will be more easily traced."

Gholson stressed the importance of writing the name of the state and the license number of the car in ink.
