Scurry County
Par Producing has completed the No. 1 Everett Unit in the Towle field, three miles east of Snyder. It was completed to produce 50 barrels of 40 gravity oil and 75 barrels of water.

Gas-oil ratio was 500-1 with perforations from 7,138-151 feet. Location is in Section 102, Block 3, H&GN survey.

WMT Operating has completed the No. 1 Minnie Falls in the Sharon Ridge field. It produced 58 barrels of 28 gravity oil and 12 barrels of water.

Gas-oil ratio was 500-1 with perforations from 2,137-162 feet. Location is in Section 132, Block 97, H&TC survey.

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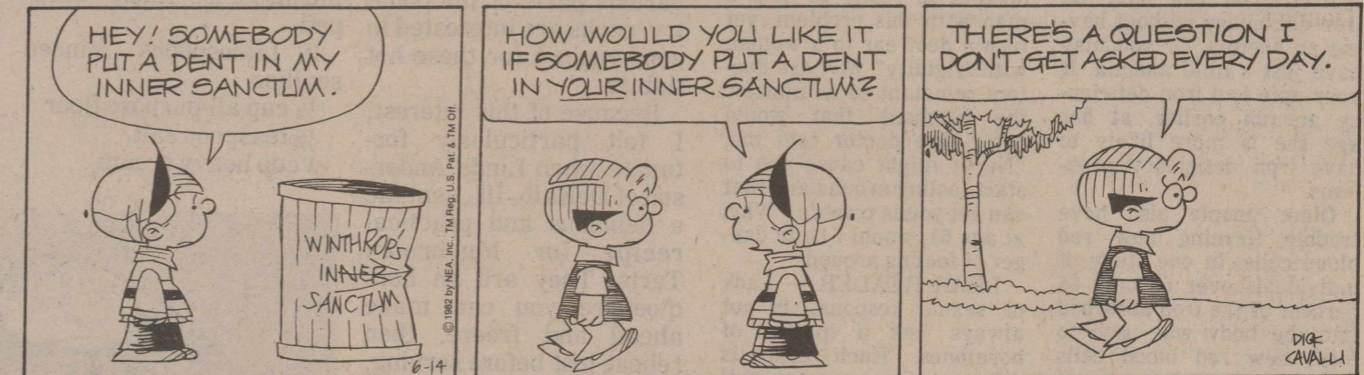
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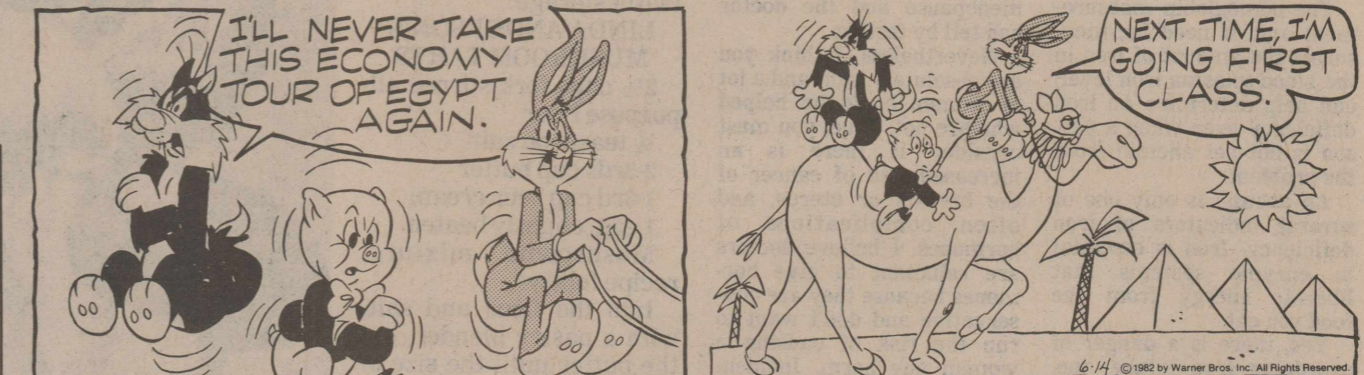
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
